Rental Rehabilitation

The Rental Rehabilitation Fund provides loans to landlords to improve the condition of their rental units for low-income tenants. The owner will work with our inspector to bring the property up to housing quality standards including improvements such as electrical, plumbing, roofs, staircases, energy conservation, etc. The funds are provided through a 6% loan, with a term of up to 15 years.

Availability: rental property owners in Cook, Lake, St Louis counties (excluding Duluth). Low-income units qualify. \$25,000 -\$100,000 loans available 6% interest rate
